Prof. Mürbe is Professor for Audiology and Phoniatics and head of the Department of Audiology and Phoniatics at the Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin. He studied medicine at the Universities of Rostock, Dublin and Dresden and graduated at the same time in vocal studies at the Dresden University of Music with an artistic diploma. Being a specialist in communication disorders his main focus is phonosurgery and conservative treatment of patients with voice disorders, especially professional voice users. Another specialization is hearing and speech rehabilitation of patients with cochlear implants.

Among the duties of Prof. Nawka is the care of patients with voice, breathing, and swallowing disorders. He is the president of the European Academy of Phoniatics (EAP) the educational branch of the Union of the European Phoniaticians (UEP). He is one of the editors of the European Manual of Medicine, Phoniatics, the textbook representing today's state of the art in phoniatics. His primary interest is voice with emphasis on diagnostics and therapy, in particular in phonosurgery.

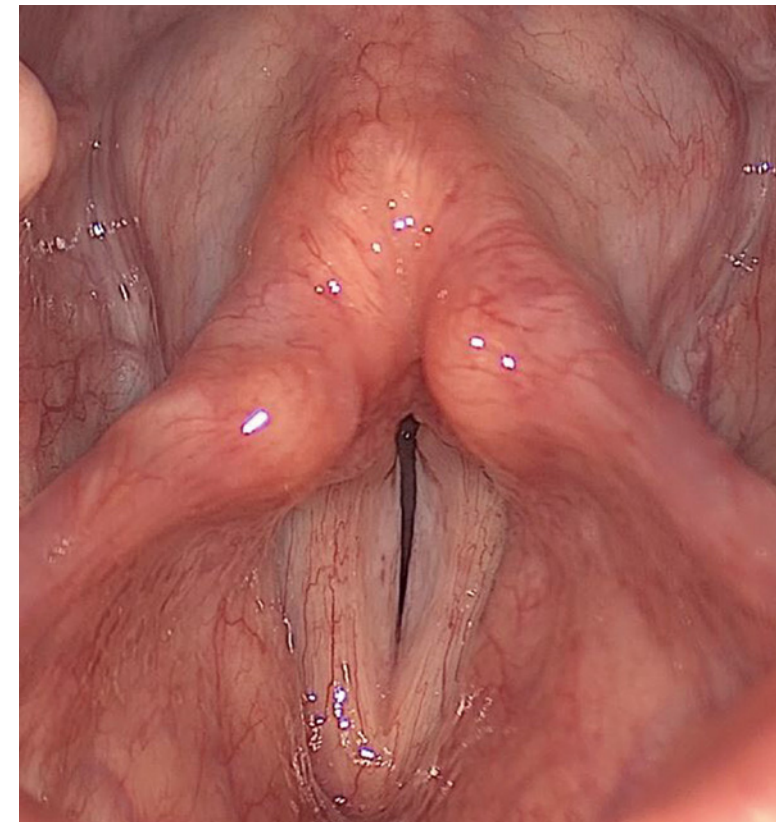
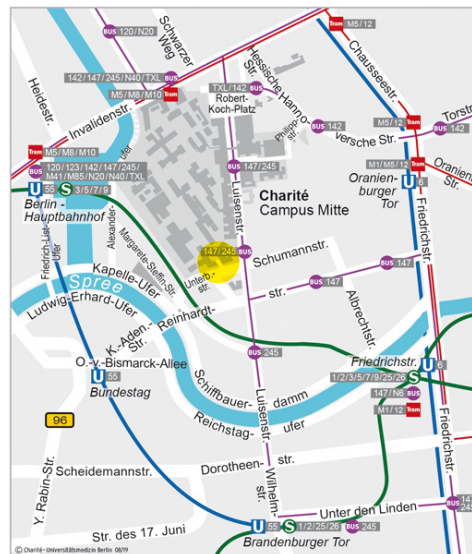
